The program affords students interested in a professional career of engagement with Asia an opportunity to pursue a flexible and varied course of instruction related to their career interests; it also serves the needs of students who wish to enter a Ph.D. program but require further background training in the field of East Asian studies.

The HYI Fellowship: HYI's [multi-year full fellowship](#) covers the two-year master's degree in Harvard's RSEA program.

HYI Fellowship Eligibility

- To be eligible for the HYI fellowship, you must be a citizen of an Asian country
- Students should be committed to pursuing a Ph.D. as preparation for an academic career and planning to return to Asia to teach upon completion of their graduate studies
- Applicants who hold degrees (or are currently enrolled in degree programs) from English-medium universities outside of Asia are ineligible for the HYI fellowship
